Long Beach Ronald McDonald House to host Walk for Kids

LONG BEACH, Calif.- After a two-year absence, The Long Beach Ronald McDonald House Charities will return to host the 11th annual Walk for Kids from 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. on May 1, 2022. The meet up area will be at the Long Beach Convention Center located on Ocean Boulevard near the Back Lot and Rainbow Lagoon.

The walk will allow donors to raise funds to help families served by Ronald McDonald House at the Long Beach location. This year's campaign aims to raise \$207,000 which will go towards programs, necessities and support the families need.

The Walk for Kids will consist of a 5k walk where people can participate as individuals, join an existing team or create a team. A festival fun zone full of vendors, activities, local radio stations, food vendors and costumed characters will be in presence.

"I'm extremely excited for the walk." said Katrina Herrera, Development Manager for the Long Beach location. "Knowing that we are helping raise money to help these families and seeing smiles on the children's faces makes it all worth it."
